Note: Eryk Sopocko is the Author of the original book "**Orzel's Patrol**", Published by Methuen, London, 1942.

Sopocko joined the Orzel for one patrol, being the first journalist to take a trip in a submarine in the war. In 1942 he wrote about his adventures and the story of Orzel in general, in the book "**Orzel's Patrol**". Sopocko and Pierzchlewski were both lost in October 1943 when the Polish destroyer ORP Orkan was torpedoed by U-378. That was the biggest Polish naval tragedy of the war, since about 200 men lost their lives.
